

PCIC conference PAPER SUBMITTAL procedure Calgary 2017

May 2 2017

Please review carefully before submitting your paper for publication in the PCIC conference record. **Only** pdf copies made through the following procedure are accepted for publication

- We are using IEEE PDF eXpress to convert your paper to .PDF format. This causes your paper to be "file compliant" for IEEE Xplore which is a conference requirement for all papers. Prepare your paper following the established PCIC PAPER FORMAT using Microsoft Word
2. **DO NOT password protect** your document.
 3. **DO NOT link the e-mail addresses of the authors**
 4. **BE SURE TO make your paper title ALL CAPS**
 5. **BE SURE EDIT MODE is turned OFF before submitting**
 6. **Follow the established PCIC PAPER FORMAT**
 - A. When your paper has been completed and approved by the Technical Sub Committee Chairperson (by e-mail) go to the IEEE PDF eXpress site:
<http://www.pdf-express.org/>
 - B. Click on the link "New Users - Click Here" and fill in your information. You will need the Conference ID which is: **20324X**
 - C. Create your new account by filling out the required information.
 - D. Create *New Title* using your Paper title, then follow the directions to submit the original source file for conversion to PDF. (See note below)
 7. After submitting your document for conversion, you will receive an e-mail with your file converted to IEEE Xplore compliant .pdf file, and a confirmation of its compliance.
 8. Save the e-mail and.pdf file to disk (do not change the document name assigned by PDF eXpress). E-mail the following files to the Technical Sub Committee chair:
 - Copy of e-mail file confirming compliance to IEEE Xplore format
 - Files of IEEE Xplore compliant copy of paper in .PDF format, and the original source file in MS WORD.doc or .docx format.Technical Sub Committee Chair will forward to the collection point via e-mail.
